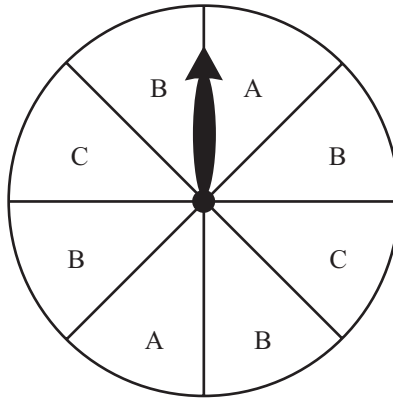

- 38 The spinner below is used in a game. All the spaces on the spinner are the same size.



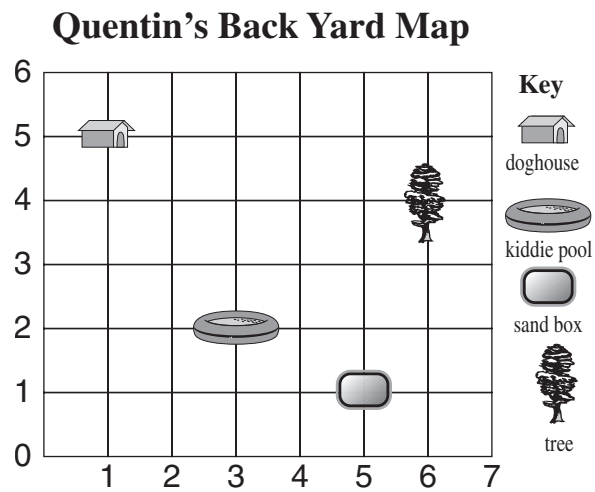
Which of the following statements about the spinner is true?
